### Please Remember to License your Pets!!

33.03.01: LICENSING OF ANIMALS (DOGS, CATS)

Every home owner within the City limits owning or possessing a dog or cat of the age of six (6) months or more shall pay the City Finance Officer an annual fee in the sum of ten (10) dollars for any neutered or spayed dog or outdoor cat and/or a fee of twenty (20) dollars for intact dog or outdoor cat. All indoor cats are exempt from fees. The same fee will apply for any additional dogs or cats up to the pet limit of four (4) pets per pet owner. **Such annual license fees shall be paid on or before the first day of January of each year** and the City Finance Officer shall, upon payment and upon sufficient proof of the required rabies vaccination issue the owner thereof a license tag. Such license tags shall be immediately attached to such animal by means of a collar or other reasonable permanent method.

### Election Dates & Information

January 27, 2012: You may start to circulate petitions on or after this date.

February 24, 2012: Petitions must be filed with the Summerset Finance Office by 5pm.

April 10, 2012: Election for Mayor and 4 Commissioners, 7am—7pm.

Petitions need at least 15 *registered voter* signatures with their registered residential address *in the City of Summerset*. Petitions must have the signatures on the front and back pages of the same document (as opposed to a separate second page). It is wise to get more than 15 signatures to help guarantee 15 *registered voter* signatures.
